New Business. Rescind ATV, UTV & Golf Cart Resolutions 2014-11 & 2014-12. A motion was made by Weier to approve **Resolution 2014-17**, a resolution which rescinds Resolution 2014-11, a resolution allowing ATV, UTV, and golf cart use on city streets and alleys, and Resolution 2014-12, a resolution requiring a fee to be paid

to the City of Linn Grove for a permit to drive ATVs, UTVs, and golf carts and city streets and alleys in Linn Grove, due to precedence of higher code of laws. Seconded by Nelson. A roll call vote was taken with voting as follows: Genson-aye, Weier-aye, Nelson-aye, Goddard-aye, and Lindahl-aye.

ATV & UTV Allowance on City Streets – 1st Reading of Ordinance Amendment. A motion was made by Weier to adopt the first reading of Ordinance No. 817, which amends current city code by allowing ATVs and UTVs to be driven on city streets and alleys. Seconded by Nelson. A roll call vote was taken with voting as follows: Genson-aye, Weier-aye, Nelson-aye, Goddard-aye, and Lindahl-aye.

Ordinance No. 816 - Dog Registration Ordinance—2nd Reading. Moved by Genson to adopt the 2nd reading and waive the 3rd reading of Ordinance No. 816, an Ordinance requiring resident owners of any dog to obtain a dog license for each dog from the City. Seconded by Weier. A roll call vote was taken with voting as follows: Genson-aye, Weier-aye, Nelson-aye, Goddard-aye, and Lindahl-aye.

Webb Wireless. Webb Wireless LLC is merging with Great Lakes Communication Corp. (GLCC). Denny Somers from Webb Wireless and Kellie Beneke from GLCC explained the merger and proposed an arrangement to the City. **Resolution 2014-18.** A motion was made by Weier to approve **Resolution 2014-18**, a resolution allowing the City to enter into an agreement with Great Lakes Communication Corp., d/b/a IGL TeleConnect, which allows IGL TeleConnect to mount and maintain equipment for Internet services to the local area on the City's water tower in exchange for free services being provided to city hall and the library and for the mayor and/or city clerk to act as a duly authorized representative to sign the agreement. Seconded by Genson. A roll call vote was taken with voting as follows: Lindahl-aye, Goddard-aye, Nelson-aye, Weier-aye, and Genson-aye.

Library Report. Library board is still seeking one more member.

Announcements & Open Forum. Repair work on the water line at Blue Bird Creek is still scheduled to take place soon.
