Graesing pointed out table and box should be removed from the ramp in front of Community Center. Graesing is also checking on prices for Fireproof filing cabinet. Jessen asked when Christmas Lights will come down and discussed possible interest in helping restore Slagle Building. Decisions need to be made timely. Mayor Anderson gave details on FEMA and Bridge Grant. FEMA Project will begin Spring of 2021. The City of Linn Grove has been awarded **\$1,000,000.00** from IDOT for assistance in Bridge Repairs. Water use discrepancy North of river has dropped to less than 1% after repairs completed.
