Old Business-Ordinance No. 819 Adopting Amendment to Water Utility Rates- 2nd Reading. Motion by Graesing to Adopt the 2nd Reading of Ordinance No 819 Title II, Chapter 1, Article 3, Sections 3.02 and 3.03 an ordinance amending the water Utility rates for the City of Linn Grove, Iowa, Seconded by Anderson. A roll call vote was taken with voting as follows: Anderson-aye, Graesing-aye, Nelson-aye, Baxter-aye. A motion by Graesing to waive the 3rd reading of Ordinance 819 2nd by Anderson. **Ordinance No. 820 Adopting Amendment to Sanitary Sewer Utility Rates- 2nd Reading.**

Motion by Anderson to Adopt the 2nd Reading of Ordinance No 820 Title II, Chapter 2, Section 8.02 an ordinance amending the Sanitary Sewer rates for the City of Linn Grove, Iowa, Seconded by Anderson. A roll call vote was taken with voting as follows Anderson-aye, Graesing-aye, Nelson-aye, Baxter-aye. Motion by Nelson to waive the 3rd reading of Ordinance 820, 2nd by Baxter. **Ordinance No. 821 Adopting Amendment to Garbage and Solid Waste Control Rates- 2nd Reading.** Motion by Nelson to Adopt the 2nd Reading of Ordinance No 821 Title II, Chapter 3, Article 10.09 an ordinance amending the Garbage and solid waste control rates for the City of Linn Grove, Iowa, Seconded by Graesing. A roll call vote was taken with voting as follows: Anderson-aye, Graesing-aye, Nelson-aye, Baxter-aye. Motion by Nelson to waive the 3rd reading of Ordinance No 821, 2nd by Baxter. Update on FEMA. Federal FEMA person coming Monday June 24th at 10 a.m. to access damage and meet with the Mayor Water Supervisor and City Clerk. Municipal Infraction 124 Weaver, junk will be removed by June 21, 2019. Nationwide Insurance claim was paid directly to the policy holder. City received a check back from Nationwide for \$94.00.

New Business- Jen Smith/Dan Van Iperen wanted 1 year temporary permit to have a tire business in their garage. The Mayor read the ordinance on having a business in a residential area. After discussion Motion by Anderson to have a Public Hearing on July 11, 2019 at the City Council Meeting, 2nd by Baxter. Resolution 2019-8 for Grow Garbage Service LLC one year contract from 7/1/19 to 6/30/20 to pick up garbage in Linn Grove for \$1,000 a month. Motion by Graesing to accept contract. 2nd by Anderson. Anderson-aye, Graesing-aye, Nelson-aye, Baxter-aye. Motion carried Resolution 2019-7 Approving the city of Linn Grove to Enter into an agreement for Law Enforcement Protection with Buena Vista County Sheriff from 7/1/19-6/30/20 for \$3,981.00. Motion by Nelson to accept contract, 2nd by Graesing. Anderson-aye, Graesing-aye, Nelson-aye, Baxter-aye. Motion carried Business in residential areas, already discussed earlier. Upcoming Elections. Papers handed out for re-election. Mayor said all voting will be in Sioux Rapids. Update of Buena Vista work at Weaver & Church on putting rock and soil in washed out areas. The ditches were seeded the day of the Council Meeting.

Library Report- City Attorney contacted about the need for a Resolution to give the Library unspent funds at the end of this fiscal year. He said a Resolution is not needed. A motion by Nelson to establish a permanent fund or encumbrance for the Linn Grove Library which can be used to channel the fiscal year ending balance along with donations and bequests to be used for the purchase of needed equipment and license fees, 2nd by Baxter. The Summer Reading Program with Bob Brown giving a drone demonstration went very well with 10 kids in attendance. Graesing & Graesing smoothed down the dirt at the playground. The swings will be moved, cement poured so we can close this phase of the playground. Abatements: Courtesy letters sent to 422 Evans and 416 Evans.
